

International Competitive Bidding (MDA/T/GD/ICB-3)



The Republic of Moldova has received financing from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria toward the cost of the Strengthening Tuberculosis control and reducing AIDS related mortality in the Republic of Moldova, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for procurement of a Digital X-Ray unit.

IP "UCIMP DS" now invites bids from eligible bidders for supply and installation of Digital X-Ray unit as follows:

LOT 1. Digital X-Ray unit – 1 unit.

-Item: Digital fluoroscopic X-ray diagnostic tomosynthesis system with dynamic flat panel detector

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the guidelines.

Submission: proposals, including required documentation listed in ICB, must be submitted only electronically on <https://e-licitatie.md/> or <https://mtender.gov.md/tenders> within the period established by SIA State Register of Public Procurement program.

Deadline: proposals are due in accordance with SIA State Register of Public Procurement program. Deadline may be automatically extended by SIA RSAP, according to clarifications solicited on the national procurement platforms. The initial established deadline is 12 February 2026, 13.00 local Chisinau time.

Late bids will be rejected by SIA State Register of Public Procurement program.

Bids will be opened at the deadline established by SIA State Register of Public Procurement program.
